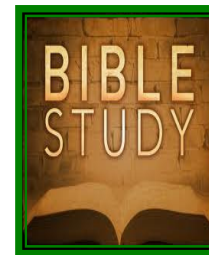

Confused about Spiritual Gifts? How do they work? Need a framework to reconcile various views, definitions and experiences? **Discovering**

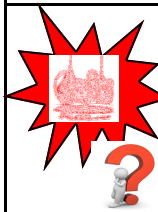
