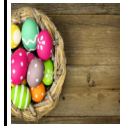
Please note...

Services of Holy Communion during the Interregnum: One of the many challenges facing us during the interregnum is to find clergy who can take the services of Holy Communion. With no curate and a shortage of clergy in the Deanery the Parochial Church Council, in consultation with the Rural Dean, is seeking to provide a weekly service of Holy Communion (except on the fifth Sunday) but for this to happen we are moving to make a change to our service pattern. Therefore as from May our service pattern will be:

1st Sunday 6:30pm	Café Communion
2nd Sunday 8:00am	Common Worship Holy Communion
3rd Sunday 10:30am	Holy Communion
4th Sunday 8:00am	Book of Common Prayer Holy Communion
