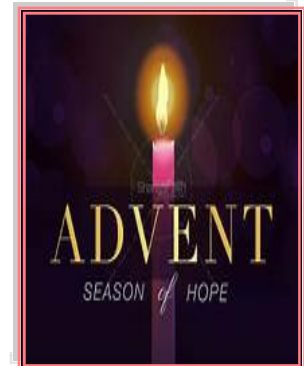

Wrights in Arua - URGENT Request for HELP: We have received an urgent request for help from John & Vicki Wright of YWAM in Arua, Uganda. Their current Discipleship Training School is the largest DTS ever, with 28 students, including those from different ethnic groups in South Sudan who have been at conflict with each other. That Discipleship has led to personal reconciliation through Christ, with tears and forgiveness, and they have been led to take this out in the outreach part of the course, at the start of the New Year, to their communities in Sudan, as well as Uganda and neighbouring D.R.Congo. The recent peace agreement in South Sudan is fragile and now is a real opportunity to extend that Christ-centred ministry of reconciliation to produce lasting change. But this costs money above the students' own contributions - up to £8,500 more than the £10,000 already raised. The PCC has agreed to encourage you to consider giving for this work, as a special offering, for which there will be a retiring collection at the back of church on both 23rd and 30th December. Alternatively, if you wanted to do this directly and add gift aid, you can do this by creating an account with Stewardship at www.stewardship.org.uk and selecting "YWAM Jinja" as the recipient, stating that it is for "YWAM Arua DTS Outreach".
