

We are amazed when we look up at the night sky. Stars stare down at us through ages of time and they are proclaiming God's glory. In Genesis 1 and 2 we see that every part of God's creation proclaims God's character and nature. When we hear a piece of music or see a fine painting it tells us about the artist or composer, but to really get to know them we need to see a picture.
