

Pavilion'd in splendour and girded with praise


O tell of His might O sing of His grace

In our passage this week, Peter urges us to *'love one another deeply above all and each one should use whatever gifts we have received, to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.'*

It is important that we recognise that,

- ◆ every one of us, as a child of God has gifts to share, whether wealth, talents or spiritual gifts.
- ◆ * that none of those gifts belong to us as *'every good gift and every perfect present comes from heaven.'* James 1:17 They are for God's glory alone.
- ◆ * that uncertain economic times might see us more reluctant to share our resources generously but serving others remains a priority for those who love God and he will not see us go without

Let us not be disheartened or distracted but manage our minds for effective praying remembering that the end of all things is near.
