

**Reading:** Luke 24:36-49 While they were still talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost. He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds? Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet. And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate it in their presence. He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms." Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. He told them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

## Thought for the day: Jon Speirs Davies

There's a word that appears in our reading this week. It's one of those words that is so simple and yet contains within it infinities of possibility and meaning. Luke records Jesus saying it. John does too but, then, he would though, wouldn't he? And in John it's... fine. John has other words he's interested in. But in Luke this word has a little something else. Resonance! It drips with the weight of what is unfolding and what is to come. When we read this word in Luke the sound gets sucked out of the universe and birds gradually slow to a halt in mid-air. Stillness and anticipation. Because we've seen this word before. Luke begins with it. A promise word. A prophecy word. And it's everywhere in Luke! He won't let you forget it! And then it finally lands and the world has never been the same since.
