



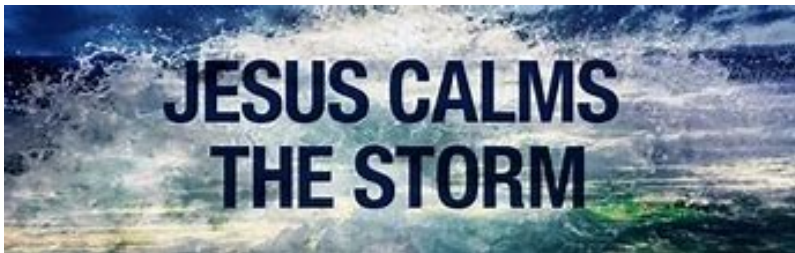

A holy nation now set apart

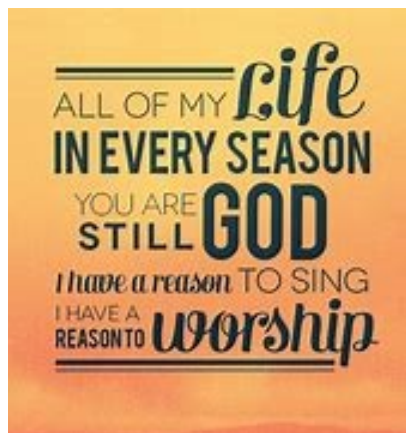
To be his hands and feet

### Reading: Luke 8:22-25

22 One day Jesus said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side of the lake." So they got into a boat and set out. 23 As they sailed, he fell asleep. A squall came down on the lake, so that the boat was being swamped, and they were in great danger. 24 The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" He got up and rebuked the wind and the raging waters; the storm subsided, and all was calm. 25 "Where is your faith?" he asked his disciples. In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."

### Thought for the day: Lis Ward

Today the people Jesus meets are already with him in a boat when a storm suddenly blows up. Jesus is asleep, apparently oblivious to the danger. The frightened disciples wake him up to tell him they are going to die. He is unperturbed, rebukes the wind and waves, the storm subsides. Usually it would take a while for waves roused by wind to calm, this is instant. Jesus challenges the disciples' faith—they have seen him do amazing things, miracles of healing and the forgiveness of sins that only God can do, yet still they were afraid. As we face sudden storms in our lives our faith is challenged: despite knowing who Jesus is, we can be fearful and find it hard to put our trust in him. Yet he is with us, and his power and authority are over all things, not just the wind and waves.

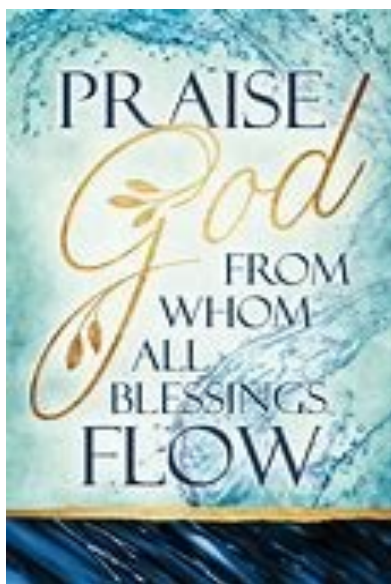
### Song 3
