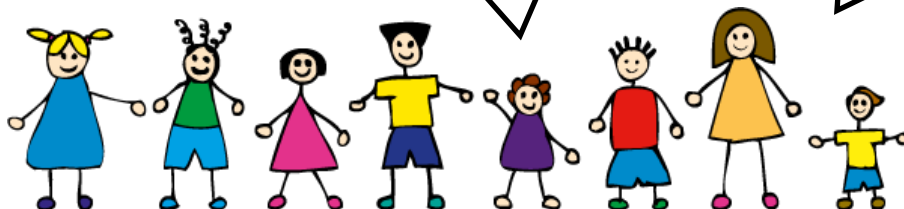

Galaxy biscuits

Need:

Rich tea biscuits or similar
icing red, blue, white
cocktail sticks
little stars (optional)

How:

1.

Put blob of each colour of icing on biscuit.
Use cocktail stick to drag through icing, care not too much or ends up muddled mess. Sprinkle a few stars over icing if wanted.

2.

Mix a little blue and red icing. To make purple.
Spread purple icing round the edge of the biscuit.
Put blobs of red and blue icing with white in the centre.
Drag cocktail stick from centre outwards.
