James: 4 Why We Fight

Reading: James 4 :4 What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? ²You desire but do not have, so you kill. You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight. You do not have because you do not ask God. ³When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.⁴You adulterous people, ^{4a} don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. ⁵Or do you think Scripture says without reason that he jealously longs for the spirit he has caused to dwell in us^{5b}? ⁶But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: "God opposes the proud but shows favour to the humble."^{6a} ⁷Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ⁸Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. ⁹Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your joy to gloom. ¹⁰Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.¹¹ Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister^{11a} or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. ¹²There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the one who is able to save and destroy. But you—who are you to judge your neighbour?¹³ Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." ¹⁴Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. ¹⁵Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." ¹⁶As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. ¹⁷If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them

Thought for the day: Nigel Andrews- What causes our quarrels? Chapter 3 ends with Godly wisdom; good, fruitful, pure, impartial, sincere and peace-loving. James says it is our selfish desires that cause conflict: greed, pride, worldly ambition; Leaving the way of Jesus, losing our first love and grieving the Holy Spirit. Repentance is the only remedy. Draw near to God in humility; acknowledge his sovereignty, renounce worldly desires and humbly submit to God's ways for us – "and he will lift you up." We cannot serve God and Mammon (worldly wealth and power). Jesus gave up everything to save us and calls us to serve and follow him in humility. Whether rich or poor, powerful or humble, we will then work together in harmony.
