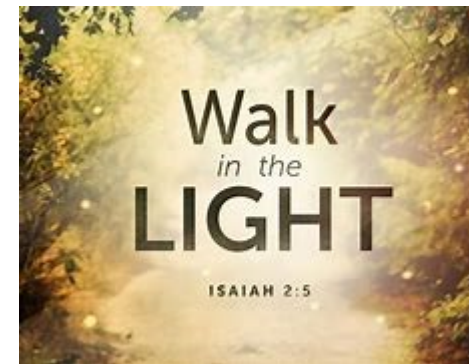

**Reading:1 John 1-1-2 : 6**

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. <sup>2</sup>The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us.

<sup>6</sup>If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth.

**Thought for the day: John Speirs-Davies:**

Now that we're getting into the 1 John part of our series - along with James it's amazing to compare the two and realise how wonderfully different they are. James has been punchy. Each instruction scarcely hits us before the next one comes along and bowls us over. The first John letter wants to do the opposite. We get lost in his meaning as he cycles around the same idea again and again. We wonder what this verse means compared to the previous when they seem to be repeating but also changing and developing. If James is like a sermon-letter inspired by the Proverbs then 1 John is like a sermon-letter inspired by the Psalms, where the words are like wading through warm sun-kissed grass that envelops everyone who has the joy to get lost in them. John just wants us to enjoy getting lost in God.
