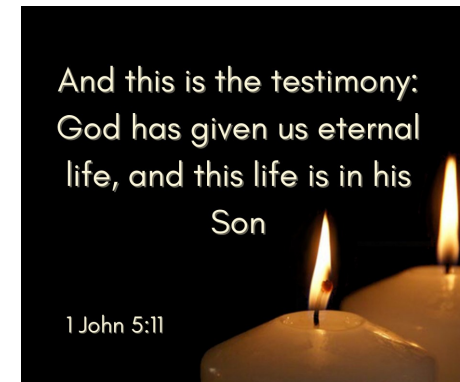

1 John 5:1-12
Faith in God's Son/The Prophets

Reading: 1 John 5:1-12 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well. ²This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands. ³In fact, this is love for God: to keep his commands. And his commands are not burdensome, ⁴for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. ⁵Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.⁶This is the one who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ. He did not come by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. ⁷For there are three that testify: ⁸the Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement. ⁹We accept human testimony, but God's testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son. ¹⁰ Whoever believes in the Son of God accepts this testimony. Whoever does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because they have not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. ¹¹ And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. ¹²Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

As we learned last week, the letter of John has a lot of repetition. So just as we were exploring our relationship with God and the love that God represents last week, now this week we're exploring further what God's love means for us. We learn that there is some incredible, good news for us at the heart of God and what God's love means. It means believing in Jesus. Being welcomed as God's children. Obeying God's commands (are they difficult or are they easy?). Trusting our creator. Overcoming the cold dark world of sin and death and all that is bad and therefore joining Jesus our Messiah in joy-filled life that lasts forever and ever and ever...!
