


**Reading: Matthew 14: 22-33** <sup>22</sup> Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. <sup>23</sup> After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. Later that night, he was there alone, <sup>24</sup> and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. <sup>25</sup> Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. <sup>26</sup> When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. <sup>27</sup> But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" <sup>32</sup> And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. <sup>33</sup> Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

This week our young people have been learning about trusting God. In Super Spies our younger kids revisited the story of Joshua and the spies and Rahab and the walls of Jericho. Everyone trusts God and does God's will and God keeps his promises. Then at Riverfest our youth have been exploring the gospel account of Jesus walking on the lake and Peter's attempt to join him. But when Peter loses faith we get to see God's mercy. Even though Peter's trust wobbled, Jesus helped him and restored him.
