Today's Reading
1 Timothy 6 : 11-21
Verse of the week : 1 Timothy 6 : 14-15
I charge you to keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which God will bring about in his own time- God the blessed Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of Lords.
Thought for the Day: Rev Lis Ward
Paul's instructions at the end of this letter are written to Timothy, a younger disciple of Jesus, whom Paul describes as a "man of God", reminding him how to live as a Christian until Jesus returns, acknowledging God as King of King and Lord of Lords. Paul says Timothy is to: flee from false teaching, fight the good fight of faith and fasten onto the hope of eternal life. Timothy is to command others in the church to forget about themselves and riches, build firm foundations based on good deeds and generosity and turn away from godless chatter and false knowledge. Why was this written? To encourage Timothy to persevere in difficult situations going on in Ephesus and to encourage early Christians to turn away from earthly gods, rulers and values and to worship the King of King and Lord and Lords, allowing him to rule over their lives. Today this passage asks us the same question - who is the King of our life and how are we allowing him to reign in us?
