What happens after the party is over? When the 175th celebrations are done? Do we stand still and complacently rest where we are now. NO! There is a lot to celebrate from the past, plenty to celebrate now, but we need to keep moving, keep going along the pathways that God calls us to, keep growing spiritually. Paul tells the Ephesians to live lives worthy of the calling they have received: we need to look at ourselves and our personal walk with God. He reminds the early Christians that Jesus equips his church with ministries that are needed to build up his body. Some may be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors, some teachers. All are needed and all have a place to play. We want to grow in maturity, personally and corporately, to do that we need to recognise the gifts God gives us and use them for his glory, each doing our own part.
