## Thought for the Day: Rev Lis Ward

Today we think about apostles – one of five ministries given by Jesus *to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up* (Ephesians 4:12). The first apostles were appointed by Jesus, sent out as proclaimers of his message and given authority by him. After Jesus' death these apostles took the lead in fellowship and prayer and chose and appointed Matthias to replace Judas. Paul describes himself as *an apostle—sent not from men nor by a man, but by Jesus Christ and God the Father* (Galatians 1:1). Other apostles were identified in the early church, including a woman Junia who is *outstanding among the apostles* (Romans 16:7). Who are apostles today? Pioneers who are sent to do new things; leaders of others who have vision for change; proclaimers who go with authority, empowered by the Holy Spirit. We need to recognise our apostles, for without them the body of Christ will not continue to grow.
