Thought for the Day: Sola Taiwo

The Lord Jesus Christ Himself has selected people into the roles and with gifts to be shepherds. As part of a few other spiritual offices, they are preparing God's people for service, thereby building up the body of Christ. Apostle Paul clarified the roles of shepherds, saying, "Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood. Acts 20.28 ESV. What shall we do in response to our Shepherds? Letters in the word – ROPE can help us. R – Remember that is paying attention to the Shepherds, who bring the word of God to you. Then imitate their faith – not everything they do – but their faithful witness in Christ. O – Obey and submit to the authority of the shepherds so that their work will be done with joy and does not become a burden because this will benefit everyone. Shepherds will and must give account. James 3v1 says they will be judged even more strictly.

P - **PRAY** - the writer of Hebrews letter pleaded 'pray for us' in the recognition that their success or fruitfulness depends on God's enabling grace. The least we can do yet the strongest. **E** - **Equip** - it was and still is a useful prayer for the great Shepherd - Jesus Christ, to equip the shepherds and everyone else so the oversight work will be according to His will and be pleasing to Him. Are you a shepherd today or in the future? As the Lord Jesus calls us to this ministry, could you respond and take up the roles for which you have and continue to be gifted? May the God of peace continue to restore and refresh the body of believers with new and renewed shepherds through Jesus Christ our Lord Amen. Keep praying for our shepherds or "ROPE" them into eternal success.
