DTS is a six-month program .I would really appreciate prayers for this time as I am getting ready to leave home. Please pray for a smooth transition in which I will be able to say goodbye to the people I have grown up with, and the place I've called home. I would also appreciate prayers for my DTS to go well, and for me to be able to prepare my heart for what God wants to say to me. The greatest challenge in my pursuit of this DTS is the financial aspect. It would be great if you would consider praying about supporting me financially. So far, I have received a pledge of \$2,000 (£1,564), which leaves an estimated \$10,100 (£7,532) to be raised.
