### Thought for the Day: Nigel Andrews

Gospel Reversed? - Galatians part1. The Galatian churches (central Turkey) had received the Gospel during Paul's first missionary tour. Now, things were going badly wrong. Some travelling teachers were insisting that they be circumcised to be saved. Paul was dismayed because this teaching directly undermined the basic Gospel truth - that salvation is God's free gift through repentance and faith in Jesus. There are **no** other legal or ceremonial requirements. A changed life **follows** salvation through faith; it was not the way to salvation. Paul condemns these false teachers in no uncertain terms. At that time our New Testament was not written. Authentic Christian teaching depended upon living Apostolic testimony. Today, we have that testimony in our hands in our own language. False teachings swirl around us today. We need to read and know our Bible to stay 'on track' and to share God's truth with those who ask.
