## **Verse of the week: Galatians 1: 11-12**

The Gospel I preached is not of human origin. I did not receive it from any man, or was I taught it, rather I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.

## **Thought for the Day: Rev Lis Ward**

Paul is writing to try to protect the Galatian Christians from the false teaching of those who believe that following Jewish legal and ritual requirements is essential for salvation. He has reminded them that only the true Gospel of grace is needed – belief in what Jesus did on the cross to save all is sufficient. In today's reading he describes the transformational power of encountering Christ, using his own life as an example. He continues to emphasise the importance of the unity that the Gospel should bring rather than division between Christians. Today we still need to hear his message. Are our lives being transformed as we encounter Jesus or are we bound by rules – our own and those of our society? And are we working for a common goal to share Jesus with others? Or do we allow our own preferences and ideas of what being a Christian is to obscure the truth?
