## Today's Reading

Galatians 3: 26-4:31

## Verse of the week: Galatians 4 : 7

So you are no longer a slave, but God's child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.

## Thought for the Day: Rev Lis Ward

Paul reminds the Galatians that they are all children of God, all baptised into or clothed with Christ and all are one in Christ Jesus. Paul is concerned that they realise they are no longer slaves to the things that have bound them in the past. They are free, adopted into God's family, and moreover his heirs and inheritors of his promises made originally to Abraham and his descendants. Now these are given for all people. What does this mean for us today?

- 1. We should respect everyone** despite our differences not seeing others as less than ourselves.
- 2. We should remember** we are loved children, part of God's family, not see ourselves as less than we are. Each of us is special to God, adopted as an heir and given an amazing inheritance.
- 3. We should rejoice** in our freedom not allowing ourselves to become slaves to religious practices or cultural customs.
- 4. We should recognise** the promises of God given through Jesus and live lives that reflect our Gospel adoption.

### LIGHT PARTY 2023: INCREDIBLE ME!

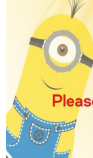
**WHAT:** A Halloween Alternative - come celebrate Jesus' light with us through games, activities and some input. Come dressed as a character from Despicable Me!

**WHERE:** The Church Lounge, Holy Trinity Church, Spilsby Road.

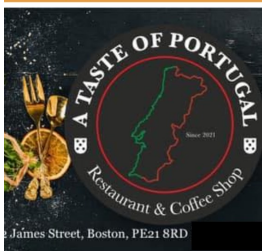
