Thought for the Day: Bishop Nicholas

How are you using what God has given you? This reading picks up the challenge from two weeks ago – what has God given us? What are we doing with our gifts and talents, money, possessions, homes, jobs, skills and interests? Are we like the third servant holding fast to what we have, burying it, only using it for ourselves. Or are we wise servants of the God of generosity? Jesus told this parable to remind his listeners there will come a day when we are all held to account before God. Jesus himself gave everything, and the riches that flow from his sacrifice on the cross and resurrection are eternal, his treasure will never perish. We have been given so much – new life in Christ as well as all the things we often take for granted. Let's commit ourselves to using what we have well so that we too will hear those words: "Well done, good and faithful servant."
