God's Strength - Finders Paradox - Habakkuk [chap 3] was prophesying around the same time as the beginning of Jeremiah's ministry. Around the time the mighty forces of the Babylonian empire were preparing to invade Judah. In the context of the paradox or intriguing perspective of some hard times when believers speak or show the strength of God during what all could see as weakness. Habakkuk was weak in fear over the looming Babylonian invasion. He was trembling, his heart pounding and 'decay crept into his bones'. He was already anticipating calamitous times of crop failures and famine that would befall their landYET he says... "I will rejoice in the Lord and ...and be joyful in GOD my Saviour". Finders of joy in trying situations are those who know their God as -God as Saviour, God as One who is Sovereign and personalised as God of MY strength. It is in Jesus Christ through the combination of His Death on the Cross. and joy of resurrection and ascension that finders of God's strength could receive joy or rejoice in times of calamity. The joy of knowing this salvation is your strength - will you come to know and have faith in God and His Son our Saviour lesus Christ? Come.
