Lots of what we believe as Christians is rooted in the gospel and what we understand about who Jesus is in terms of His life, death and resurrection. We learn a lot through the Gospels of what we can expect to happen in 'the end times', as signs of Jesus' return. Our passage this week is taken from Mark 13, when Jesus speaks to some of his disciples and goes into some detail about these signs - but one thing He reiterates is how He wants them to 'stand firm' and 'be on their guard' no matter what happens. There will be wars and rumours of wars, earthquakes and natural disasters, and people will have disagreements with each other - but we know that when Jesus comes back again in glory, there will be no mistaking Him. He will come with might and power, and we can live today because of God's gift to us of the Holy Spirit. He can give us the wisdom in what to do and the words to say when playing our part in sharing the Gospel

Road HoG Bus Youth Project Update: Thank you to friends from the Trinity family who have faithfully supported the roadHoG Bus Youth Project over the years and also supported the continuation of the project with the building of the new bus. Progress on the new bus has been slow, but positive. We are now very pleased to announce that the collection date for the finished bus is the 8th March 2024. The bus is no longer in London bus red but the more familiar roadHoG purple! We look forward bringing the bus to church soon and to sharing the love of God, in Jesus, to the young people of our area in the new roadHoG bus!
