The King is coming Holy week starts with Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Later, he curses a fruitless fig tree and clears the traders out of the Temple Court intended for all the Nations to worship God. After his teaching and confronting the temple authorities, he is rejected by the masses, betrayed, tried, abused and crucified. The people were disappointed and offended – he didn't 'measure-up' to their Messianic expectations. Yet, he is, indeed, the true King of Glory, the Son of God, God's appointed Saviour and Messiah. He is the wise, gentle and true shepherd of God's people. What kind of king do we expect in Jesus? The events of Holy Week give us opportunity to pause and consider more deeply – to revise wrong expectations and attitudes; to repent and renew an honest and realistic commitment to our sovereign Lord.
