Some things are unbelievable but true, the resurrection of Jesus is one of them. When Mary, the first witness to share the good news that Jesus was alive, told the disciples, they doubted. When the two disciples who met Jesus while walking in the countryside confirmed what Mary has said, they too were not believed. When Jesus appeared to the disciples, he told them off for not believing. Today he gives us the same three instructions... Believe, tell, and be baptised. We need to do all three. It is not enough to believe Jesus is alive and keep our faith private. We need to ask the Holy Spirit to give us words to share the good news of who Jesus is and what he has done for us. Good news that is too good not to share. And if we believe and want to tell others, baptism is a great way of showing our faith is important to us. Why would we not want to follow Jesus' instructions!
