No doubt many of you will have been engrossed in the Olympics over the last couple of weeks watching our athletes do battle with the other world nations. As people who belong to God, we exist within our own battle. It's not a perceived matter of life or death like the Olympics – it is an actual matter of life or death. 'Our struggle is not against flesh and blood it's against the rulers, the authorities and the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.' We would be fools to think we could compete without appropriate armour and weaponry! Thankfully, God has equipped us with both. The 'armour of God,' when claimed, 'preserves our minds and hearts against the enemy's fiery darts' (v16) designed to put us off our game, and we are well advised 'to pray in the Spirit on all occasions, with all kinds of prayers and requests (v18). Prayer is the greatest and most effective weapon we have at our disposal - and it sends the opposition running scared!
