Thought for the Day:

Sometimes we come across people who make what they do look easy. It has been said many times that the tennis player, Federer, possessed a gift for the game - he was so fluid and graceful in his movements. His response to comments like this was to say that "Most of the time it isn't about having gift. It is about having grit." Paul is under no illusion that Timothy's task of leading the church in Ephesus will be a stroll in the park and in today's reading he encourages him to apply himself in three areas. The first is to learn from the athlete, the soldier and the farmer - he will need to focus on his task and be ready for patient endurance. Secondly he is to work hard to be approved as he studies and shares the word of truth. And finally when he is correcting misunderstandings, errors and wrong teaching, he is to do so courteously, patiently and without getting into heated arguments. We might do well to ask ourselves how we fare in these three areas.
