Thought for the Day

Imagine you're in prison awaiting execution and that you're asked if you have any last words. I wonder what those words would be? Paul chooses to use his time in prison to send words of loving encouragement and warning to Timothy - that he might grow in faith and continue to steer a Godly path - and so the first part of 2 Timothy 3 highlights some of the toxic people he needs to avoid and their poisonous practices; money lovers, sacrilegious God scoffers, proud hedonists, predators and false teachers. The second half of the chapter focuses on the antidote - Continued overleaf ...

Unlike Paul who experienced a sudden conversion to faith, Timothy was taught the scriptures from childhood by his mum and granny!
