Holy Trinity's Church Family has various types of pastoral and prayer support. Many members are involved with small groups or prayer partnerships as well as being known to Church friends and the Pastoral Team. Folk with on-going needs, because of frailty, immobility or long-term conditions will usually be known to the Pastoral Team, church friends or small group members.

The Weekly Update includes a number of names where reasons for regular inclusion may now be unclear. In order to clarify the need, our Pastoral Outreach Worker (Susan Mathews) will be contacting a number of people to review their weekly inclusion.

Generally, names need only to be included for about 4 weeks following request, to inform the wider Church Family. Thereafter, names will be removed from the weekly posting while those closest to them can continue to up-hold them in regular prayer. They can be included again if situations change.

Requests for inclusion during the Service Intercessions can be sent to our Pastoral Outreach Worker by Wednesday, or directly to Liz Leggott our prayer rota co-ordinator. The names will then be sent to the person leading intercessions that week.

The Prayer Chain will continue to receive requests to cover urgent situations.
