<p>Temptation – Lk 4:1-11. Jesus has just been publicly affirmed by the Father and dramatically filled with the Holy Spirit; to equip him for his public ministry of teaching, healings, miracles, suffering and death. He retreats to be alone with God and commit, totally, to serve his Father. Satan tempts him, aiming to derail his ministry and so block the Gospel, the kingdom of God, modelled by Jesus' faithful ministry and death. Like us, in his humanity, Jesus was vulnerable; "He was tempted <u>in every way</u> just as we are – yet without sin" (Heb 4:15). Jesus knows <u>exactly</u> what it is be human – and sympathises with us when we come to him. He answers Satan with the words of Scripture and steadfast commitment to serving the Father – as we can too. Jesus' earthly example and discipleship training show us the ultimate potential in a human being, fully devoted to serving God.</p>

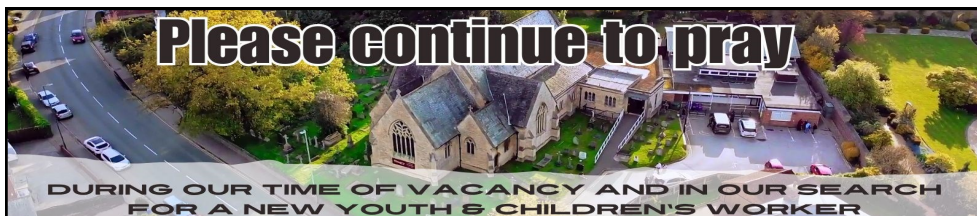
