Not my King? Palm Sunday marks the start of Holy Week. Jesus hailed as king but is eventually rejected by the people and crucified. They rejected his kingship because of personal prejudices, false expectations and fears. These same attitudes determine our responses to Jesus today; in society and even within the Church community. Jesus is Lord and King of all – an eternal truth, affirmed by his life, death and resurrection. The disciples, watching and learning, gradually understood who he was, up to the point of realisation and total commitment. This is true for us today - As we learn and experience more of him, we come to the point of realisation. He confronts us with a choice. Ultimately, to accept as Lord and God or to reject him; To commit to him or to back away. Will you have Jesus to be your king - Lord in everything?
