Hannah's story in 1 Samuel 1:20-28 is not just about a mother's love but about faith, sacrifice, and trust in God's purpose. When Samuel was born, she fulfilled her vow, entrusting him to God's service.

Hannah's sacrifice was rooted in faith, gratitude, and obedience. She believed in a loving God, recognised Samuel as a divine gift, and remained faithful to her promise. Her selfless love reflects the broader calling of "mothering"—a role not limited to biological motherhood but encompassing mentorship, guidance, and care.

Mothering Sunday celebrates all who embody God's nurturing love. Just as Hannah entrusted Samuel to God, we are called to trust Him with those we love. The church, like a parent, nurtures, challenges, and prepares us to grow in faith and serve others.

Holy Trinity's Church Family has various types of pastoral and prayer support. Requests for inclusion during the Service Intercessions can be sent to our Pastoral Outreach Worker by Wednesday, or directly to Liz Leggott our prayer rota co-ordinator. The names will then be sent to the person leading intercessions that week.

The Prayer Chain will continue to receive requests to cover urgent situations.
