# Thought for the Day: Dave Parkinson

In one of his discourses Jesus said to his listeners, "You will know the truth and the truth will make you free." Those who place their trust in him, who are united with him, find freedom. In our Galatians reading (Galatians 3: 23-29) Paul goes to great lengths to make it very clear that no one can be made right with God by trying to keep the law handed down from Mount Sinai. It can't be done. But Christ brings freedom from that failure because he is the true way to God the Father. In our Gospel reading (Luke 8: 26-39) Luke is describing the fear of the demon possessed man, and the fear of the herdsmen and townsfolk who lived in the area. Jesus brings freedom into this situation.
