Relational Faith: 2 Timothy 1:1-14 Jesus taught and modelled the faith of the kingdom of God. His disciples learnt in relationship; by hearing and observation, shared experiences, trials and mistakes. Not 'head-learning' but 'heart-learning'. We forget facts and logic. Experience becomes grafted into our lives and consciousness. Faith and action become instinctive and practical. Paul wrote, "I know whom I have believed". After the Damascus encounter, Jesus became his living Lord. That relationship can be our too. The Holy Spirit "will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have said to you" (John 14:26). Christian faith is relational, personal and shared; in fellowship and by mentoring. Paul invested time and energy in the young Timothy; mentoring him for leadership. We need to do the same, as we have opportunity, sharing living faith with our young people, in our families and in fellowship and small groups. Passing-on the Baton!
