

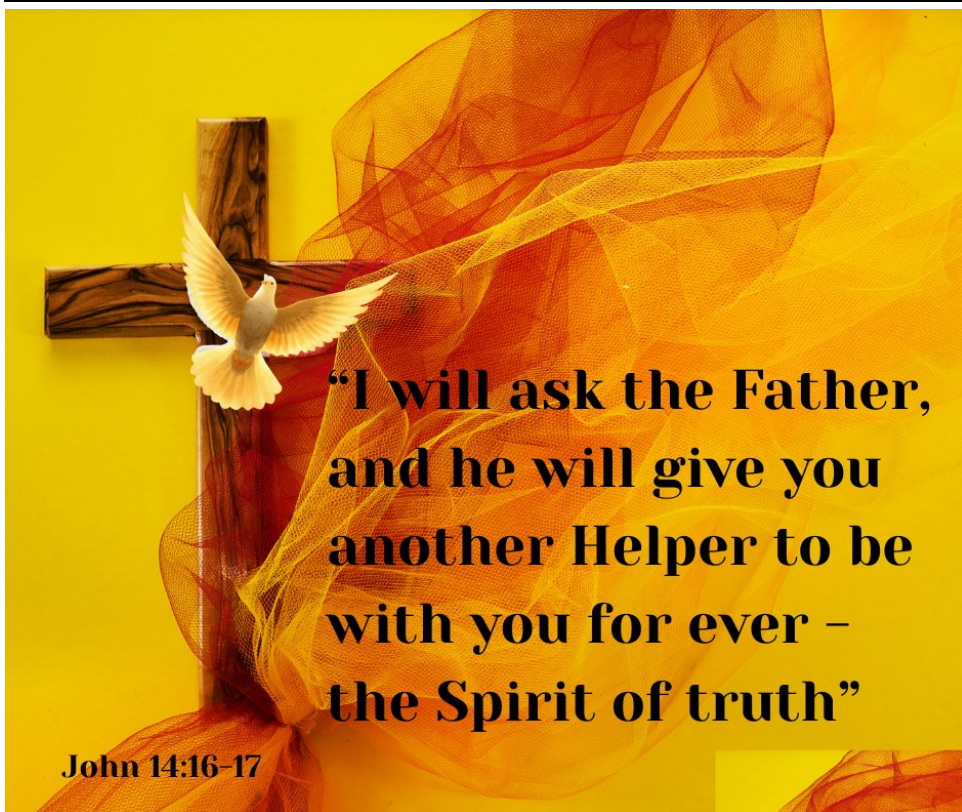

The Youth Ministry Lead position has received just a couple of applicants and there will be a meeting shortly to go through these and decide whether to invite for interview.

Christmas services were reviewed and it was thought generally well received. Some aspects needed improving, e.g. use of leaflets, and prayer beforehand. It was agreed to further support **John & Vikki Wright** financially as they prepare to return to UK.

No buyer has come forward to purchase **43 Spilsby Road**.

It was a 'quieter' PCC being the first of the New Year.

Also some feedback following the meeting about **Tots and Milkshake Shack** last Wednesday. There is a strong Tots team and this will return with some changes on 25th February at 10am. The team will be meeting again early February to sort the toys and plan for new equipment.

At present there isn't an adequate team for Milkshake Shack, another meeting is to be held on 28th January at 3pm to discuss a way forward for reaching out to families. If you are interested please get in touch with Louise.
