CAP is looking to equip churches in Boston with the tools to bring transformational debt help to the lives of the most vulnerable because with the cost of living crisis they are seeing people in our community struggling to afford food and heating and the situation is likely to get worse. The event is on Wednesday 25th February, 2:00pm—3:30pm at Centenary Methodist Church, Boston. Refreshments provided.

A Message from Adrian: Again some feedback from this week's PCC on 10th Feb ... We are starting to experiment from how PCC meetings work, with one month focusing on admin/finance/fabric etc and the next focusing more on vision/strategy etc. This last PCC focused on the latter ...

There were two applicants for the Youth Worker post and it was decided not to invite any for interview. The post is now being re-advertised. Please do pray for the right person to come...

A proposal was accepted to give further funding to Centrepont Outreach. A 2k fund will allow the Centre to offer loans to clients with various needs.

PCC spent a lot of time in small groups discussing how as a church we can 'Grow Younger'. The changes already made (e.g. children's corner) were reviewed, and thoughts about other ways we can encourage growth were explored including what has happened in the past at Trinity, ensuring opportunities for people to become Christians on Sunday mornings, plus many other. These are all being collated. A proposal to buy a portable baptistry was approved. This will allow for full immersion baptisms to happen at Trinity. Hopefully we will be able to get one for Easter Sunday as a number of people have expressed an interest to be baptised.
