**Thought for the Day: Nigel Andrews**

“Who is this?” people asked. Jesus rode into Jerusalem, surrounded by cheering crowds. He arrived as a peace-time king, fully aware that arrest, betrayal and death would come. Our Passover lamb – the ultimate sacrifice for sins.

Jesus provokes a response. Some worshipped, some were afraid, others bemused. If He is Messiah, we repent and believe; worshiping him as Lord of our lives. Just following the crowd will not bring personal salvation – within days, the crowd preferred a rebel and condemned him. The Authorities feared a coup. Jesus had to be stopped! Authority still fears the power of faith to change lives.

He is too important to be ignored. We have the best evidence of all in the New Testament – better than for any other historical person. The truth is there – if we will read, study and believe. The real bar is unbelief – the challenge of accepting the need to change our lives.

### **Some feedback from the PCC on 10th March**

Youth worker update - there have been a number of enquiries with several CVs sent. Closing date for applications is 31st March so do keep on praying.

Paula fed back on a Christians Against Poverty (CAP) in Boston meeting that has been recently held. A number of churches are exploring together a possible partnership with CAP for the Boston area. If you would like to know more please do speak to Paula.

The current Mission partners were reviewed and PCC approved all for continued support.

The 8am Holy Communion service is to finish at the end of March. There are simply not enough numbers to make this viable. A discussion was had around whether to increase the number of Communion services a month at the 10:30am and it was decided to trial having two a month, on the 1st Sunday (the All-age service) and the 3rd Sunday which we currently have.

The annual finance reports are with the auditor and will be ready for presenting to the church at the APCM.

There has been some interest in 43 Spilsby Road, but no serious offers yet.

# ELECTORAL ROLL REVISION

If you signed up last year you do not need to do it again if you wish to join this year please see the information below.

## HOLY TRINITY BOSTON

### *What is it?*

It is your parish church's register of electors. In the same way that being on the civic Electoral Roll allows you to vote in parliamentary and local elections and referenda, joining the Church Electoral Roll means that you can vote on Church matters, attend the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) and stand for election to the PCC.

### *Why do I need to join it?*

Joining the Roll is compulsory if you wish to:  
Stand for election to the PCC or other synodical council (such as the Deanery, Diocesan or General Synod) Attend the APCM and participate in votes

### *How do I join it?*

Application forms can be completed today or obtained from the Church Office. Fill in your full name and address, and tick the appropriate boxes
