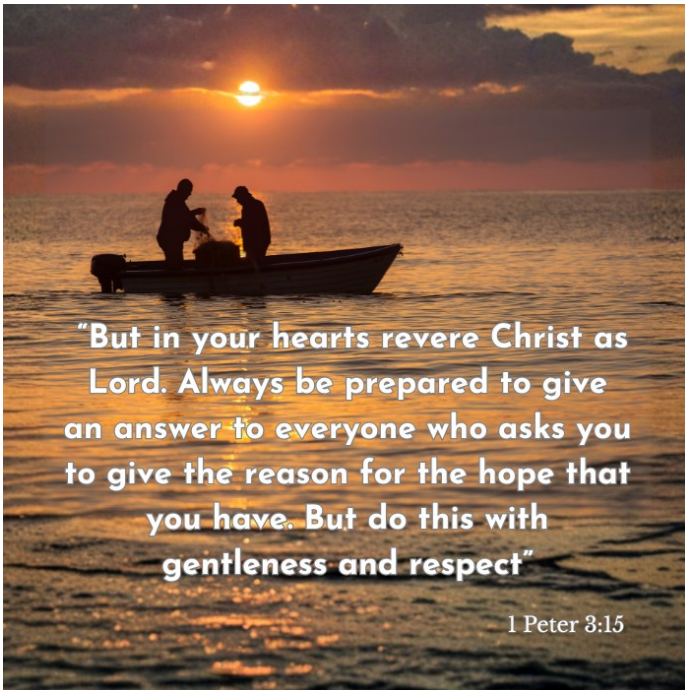

An Update from Centrepoint Outreach: Thanks to generous private donations, and successful applications to the National Lottery Community Fund and other grant funders, Centrepoint Outreach is currently undertaking a building project to renovate its premises in Red Lion Street, Boston. These works will provide improved facilities including a larger drop in lounge, an additional shower, a catering style kitchen and meeting pods for one-to-one meetings. It has been necessary to vacate the premises for approximately 6 months whilst the works are underway. The drop-in sessions are currently being held in the Blenkin Memorial Hall and the charity shop has relocated temporarily to Unit 18A Pescod Square (opposite Costa Coffee). MAF News: Update from Stewart Ayling

Dear friends, After 15 years serving with MAF here in Tanzania we have some difficult news to share:

MAF International have announced that they will be ending their flying in Tanzania. A decision has been taken, by the Executive Leadership Team, to prioritise flying in support of the Sudan Crisis in the coming few years and so they will be allocating people and aircraft in order to maximise the impact in that area.

The scale of the humanitarian crisis in Sudan is huge, with more than 12 million people displaced and nearly 25 million experiencing acute food insecurity and so it's difficult for us to dispute the need for MAF's support.

At the same time we continue to see the situation in isolated villages around Tanzania, where people have no access to basic services and are forgotten by the World unless our flights come - this is one of the difficult dilemmas of serving with a mission organisation.

We will be continuing our regular flights, in Tanzania, until the end of 2026 at present.

There is an ongoing discussion with another like-minded mission organisation about them taking over the work and we hope that this would allow the village clinics and evangelistic outreach work to continue. However there are many discussions and details to be worked through for this hope to become a reality.

At a time like this we are so very grateful for our many supporters who continue to give and particularly to pray for us so faithfully. We are not quite sure of what the outcome will be from these coming months but we know our God is faithful and He is good.

We would particularly ask you to pray with us for a good outcome to the discussions with this other mission for all of our staff and their families as we face this uncertain time together. For the many isolated communities around Tanzania that we have served or continue to serve, during the organisation's 63 years in the country.
